

Work Continues on Minimum Wage

The House General, Housing and Military Affairs Committee will continue work on the Senate-passed proposal to increase the minimum wage to \$15 per hour by 2024. Business groups have lined up on both sides of the issue with several in support and several opposed. The Vermont Chamber will testify in support for an annual

increase based on the consumer price index, consistent with current law. However, we will share concerns about the accelerated pace of this minimum wage proposal. We endorse the concept of decoupling tip wage from the minimum wage and maintaining the student wage, with further clarification.

The Committee will hold a public hearing on Thursday, April 5, 2018 from 5:30 to 7:30 pm. The hearing will take place in Room 11, located on the first floor of the State House, near the main entrance. Witnesses can start signing up to speak at 5:00 pm. Witness testimony will be limited to only two or three minutes. The Committee will also accept written testimony.
